

Privacy Policy & Terms of Use – 4 April 2020 – Revision 2

At ABATEofAZ.org and ABATEofAZ.us (the “Websites”) we are committed to safeguarding and preserving the privacy of our visitors. This Privacy Policy and Terms of Use document (the “Policy”) explains what happens to any personal data that you provide to us, or that we collect from you whilst you visit our site and how we use cookies on this Websites.

We do update this Policy from time to time so please do review this Policy regularly.

Information That We Collect

In running and maintaining our Websites we may collect and process the following data about you:

- We may collect anonymous information about your use of our site including details of your visits such as pages viewed and the resources that you access. Such information includes traffic data, location data and other communication data.
- Information provided voluntarily by you. For example, when you join, update your membership or make a purchase.
- Information that you provide when you communicate with us by any means.

Use of Cookies

Cookies provide information regarding the computer used by a visitor. We may use cookies where appropriate to gather information about your computer in order to assist us in improving our Websites.

We may gather information about your general internet use by using the cookie. Where used, these cookies are downloaded to your computer and stored on the computer’s hard drive. Such information will not identify you personally; it is statistical data which does not identify any personal details whatsoever.

Our advertisers may also use cookies, over which we have no control. Such cookies (if used) would be downloaded once you click on advertisements on our Websites.

You can adjust the settings on your computer to decline any cookies if you wish. This can be done within the “settings” section of your computer. For more information please read the advice at AboutCookies.org. Note that disabling cookies may render certain parts of our Websites inoperable.

Use of Your Information

We use the information that we collect from you to provide our services to you. In addition to this we may use the information for one or more of the following purposes:

- To provide information to you that you request from us relating to our products or services.
- To provide information to you relating to other topics that may be of interest to you. Such additional information will only be provided where you have consented to receive such information.
- To inform you of any changes to our Websites, services or goods and products.
- To provide you with any services that may be a benefit of being a member, such as Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance.

If you have previously purchased goods or services from us, we may provide to you details of similar goods or services, or other goods and services, that you may be interested in.

Storing Your Personal Data

In operating our Websites, it may become necessary to store data that we collect from you in our online database. By providing your personal data to us, you agree to this transfer, storing and processing. We do our utmost to ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to make sure that your data is stored securely.

Unfortunately, the sending of information via the internet is not totally secure and on occasion such information can be intercepted. We cannot guarantee the security of data that you choose to send us electronically, sending such information is entirely at your own risk.

We do NOT store any credit card information on our Websites, databases or servers. Credit Card data is gathered and processed by a third-party processing service. You may elect to have your card stored with them for future use, but we recommend against that practice.

Disclosing Your Information

We never give your details to third parties or use your data to enable them to provide you with information regarding unrelated goods or services that are not an advertised benefit of membership and we will never sell your details to anyone, ever.

We will not disclose your personal information to any other party other than in accordance with this Policy and in the circumstances detailed below:

- Where we are legally required by law to disclose your personal information.
- To further fraud protection and reduce the risk of fraud.
- If you are a member, or join as a member, to a single, third party, insurance vendor that will provide you with a free Accidental Death & Dismemberment Insurance Policy.

On occasion we include links to third parties on these Websites. Where we provide a link, it does not mean that we endorse or approve that site's policies towards visitor privacy. You should review their privacy policy before sending them any personal data.

Access to Information

ABATE of AZ believes you have the right to access any information that we hold relating to you. Please note that we reserve the right to charge a fee of \$10 to cover costs incurred by us in providing you with the information.
